

## Coaching Sessions – Suggested Topics

Below is a list of topic suggestions for your Cricket Club. It makes sense to begin at the beginning with warping, but don't think of these sessions as your Weaving 101 class broken down into subsections. They are play dates! You can start anywhere you want depending on the expertise in your group.



### **Tip Off: Warping your loom**

Use the Cricket manual to show students how warp up their loom fast using a warping peg.

### **Sett It: How to choose yarn**

Our handy sett guide in a bookmark format is a great give-away that helps your customers understand how to pick yarns for their projects.

### **Get the Beat: How to weave to get the fabric you want**

Show your customers how beat effects hand, by demonstrating the difference between warp-faced and weft-faced fabrics.

### **Strong Finish: Find the right finish for your project**

Demonstrate hemstitching, twisted fringe, and other popular finishing techniques.

### **Pick Up: Introducing texture to your warp**

Use our handy handout on our dealer only page to show how the pick-up stick can open up whole new avenues for designing fabric.

### **Lace Up: Hand-manipulated techniques**

Offer a short demonstrations of leno and other hand manipulated techniques.

### **Felt It: Needlefelting on woven cloth**

### **Stitch It: Adding crochet and knitted trims**

These can be knit separately or right onto the cloth.

### **Step Up: Weaving with two heddles — an introduction to the Flip**
